THE COMMUNITY

Cedar Falls is an Iowa community of approximately 41,000 people and is part of a larger metropolitan area shared by Waterloo. One of the largest employers in Cedar Falls is the University of Northern Iowa, an Iowa Regents institution of approximately 9,000 students. Other educational institutions in the metropolitan area are Hawkeye Community College and Upper Iowa University. The Cedar Falls Community School District is the 15th largest in the state of Iowa, serving 5920 students. As one of the largest employers in Black Hawk County, the school district has over 800 employees; full and part time.

THE SCHOOL

Cedar Falls High School is a comprehensive high school of approximately 1,292 students in grades 10 through 12. Freshmen students attend at one of two junior high schools. In the 2020-21 school year the district also started a virtual K-12 school. The district has seven elementary schools. The school day is comprised of seven 40-minute periods. The school calendar is comprised of two eighteen-week semesters. The school is also comprehensive in the variety of activities offered to its students and is recognized statewide for outstanding programs in athletics, music, and drama. Cedar Falls High School is accredited by the Iowa Department of Education. The school has enjoyed a long history of high community expectations and support, including the passage of a local option tax twice in the last fifteen years. A bond issue to build a new high school was passed in the summer of 2019 and projected to open in the 2024-25 school year.

THE FACULTY AND ADMINISTRATION

The secondary schools have approximately 213 FTE licensed staff members, 64.7% of who have earned a master's degree or above. The student-licensed staff ratio is 14.2. More than 166 teachers, administrators, and support staff are employed at CFHS. The CFHS Alternative Program staff includes two teachers and one counselor.

MEDIA AND TECHNOLOGY

The district and community has always made technology a commitment with the passage of the instructional support levy in 1991 resulting in a dramatic infusion of state-of-the-art media and technology. Both students and teachers are using the power of technology in daily teaching and learning outcomes. The instructional support levy was renewed in 2011 for another ten years. CFHS became a 1:1 school with students using Google Chromebooks during the 2nd semester of 2014.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Cedar Falls High School requires that students successfully complete forty-five semester credits to graduate. A CFHS Core Diploma requires completion of forty semester credits. Requirements include English (8), mathematics (6), science (6), social studies (6) financial literacy (1), and fine or practical arts (2). Students must also pass two semesters per year of physical education and .5 credit of Health. Physical education is awarded .5 credits per class. All students are required to carry at least six academic subjects in addition to physical education. Grade point average is based on a 4.0 scale with AP classes weighted on a 5.0 scale starting in the 2016-17 school year. CFHS eliminated class rank in the 2014-15 school year. Cedar Falls High School has fully implemented Standards Based Grading during the fall of 2019-20 school year. Standards Based Grading with strand scores determines the grade: A=All 4's or mostly 4s and no 2s or 1s. B=Mostly 3s with at least one 4 with no 2s or 1s. C=All 3s or mostly 3's and no 1s. D=All 2s or mostly 2s. F=All 1s or mostly 1s. In the spring semester of 2019-20 during the COVID19 shutdown, students earning credit chose either an earned letter grade or a P (pass). Students not earning credit received no credit (W) in lieu of a failing grade (F).

ADVANCED PLACEMENT/ACCELERATED COURSES

Cedar Falls High School offers Advanced Placement courses in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Science, Calculus, Statistics, History, Music, Psychology, Government, Human Geography, Computer Science, Language and Composition, and Literature and Composition, French and Spanish. Accelerated or honors courses are offered in Mathematics, Science, English, Social Studies and World Language. Level IV World Language is available in French, German, and Spanish. Qualified students also take courses at approved colleges and universities under the Postsecondary Enrollment Options Act. Students may also take concurrent courses from Hawkeye Community College in Art, Business, CAPS, English, Family Consumer Science, Industrial Technology, Math, PLTW, Social Studies and World Language.

NATIONAL MERIT AND COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAMS

For years Cedar Falls High School has produced National Merit Scholarship Finalists, Semifinalists, and Commended Students. This recognition is administered through the National Merit Scholarship Corporation. In the 2021-2022 school year four students have been designated as National Merit Semifinalists and one Commended Student.

Students in the class of 2021 who took the ACT included 42%. Comparative mean ACT scores of students nationwide, students in Iowa and students at Cedar Falls High are listed below:

Typically, no more than 10 students take the SAT. Mean scores for such a small sample have relatively little statistical significance and therefore are not included in this school profile.

POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION

Approximately 77 percent of Cedar Falls High School graduates continue their education beyond high school. About 53 percent of the graduates attend four-year colleges and universities; 24 percent attend community colleges and public or proprietary vocational/technical schools. CFHS has a graduation rate of 96%. Over 80% of the secondary students are involved in student activities.
